Introduction and Eligibility Requirements

Welcome to the ASID Missouri West / Kansas Leadership in Design Scholarship Application. 2019 marks our twelfth year of awarding scholarships to students pursuing a degree in Interior Design. We have enhanced our program this year with the goal of encouraging and empowering **students – our future emerging professionals and design leaders** – to transition into becoming the new voice of our organization.

Four \$750 scholarships are available. Scholarships will be awarded based on outstanding leadership and academic achievement while enrolled in an Interior Design program.

Scholarship winners will also receive a voucher to cover their first year of ASID National Membership dues (An \$85 value towards the “Advance to ASID Allied” membership program.) The voucher will be honored by ASID MOW / KS upon proof of the recipient’s graduation.

As a professional member of ASID you are eligible for immediate opportunities to be a change leader as a Committee Chairperson, as well as consideration for a voting position on the ASID MOW / KS Board of Directors.

Criteria for Scholarship Eligibility

1. Current enrollment in an Interior Design Program for an Associate’s or Bachelor’s degree
2. Successful completion of a minimum of one year (30 semester hours or the equivalent) studies towards an Interior Design program
3. Current Student Member of ASID
4. Minimum GPA of 3.0
5. Not a previous recipient of a student scholarship from ASID MOW / KS

Application Inclusion Requirements

1. Contact Information and Academics
2. Activity Involvement and Leadership Essay
3. Resume and Signature
4. Two letters of reference from academic, professional, or volunteer contacts
5. Official College Transcripts to include Interior Design program classes completed
6. Proof of current class schedule or enrollment documentation

The required letters of reference, proof of current enrollment, and official college transcripts need to each be submitted in their own sealed, and signed envelope.
